


Back to Business **Kenosha Area Employer Survey Results**





Question #1: What measures are you implementing in your organization? Choose all that apply.






Question #3: What is the current status of those remote employees?




*Other responses:

- returning to the office in stages, a few employees brought back each week
- > Some back 100%, others still remote
- Most full time employees are in the office but are flexible and can remote in. We're staggering support staff hours.
- Staff that can work remotely come in based on the business needs. We estimate a full return in June, yet continuing to monitor the situation and make adjustments accordingly.

- *Entered return date:
