

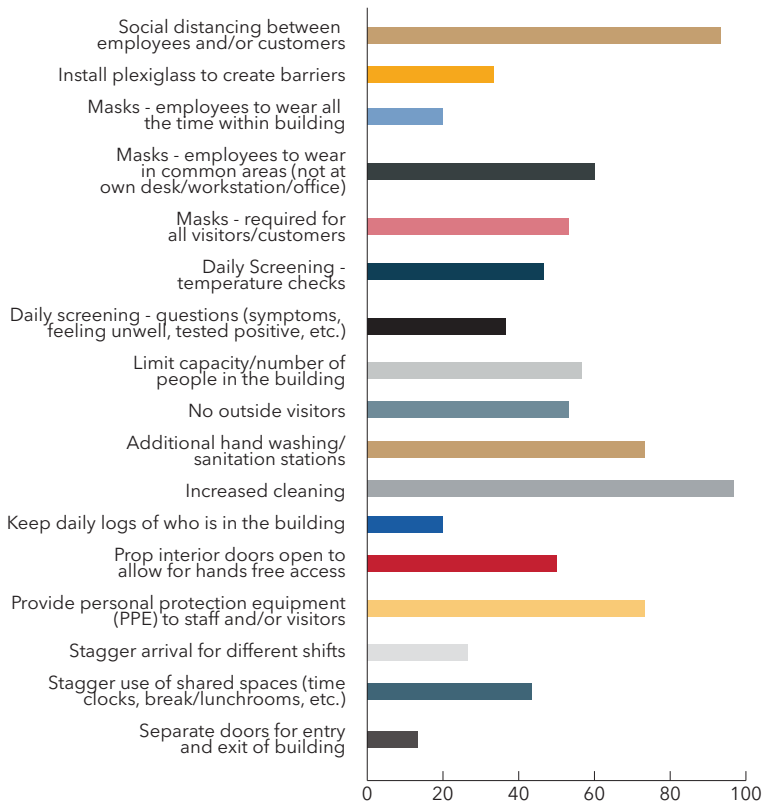
# Back to Business Kenosha Area Employer Survey Results

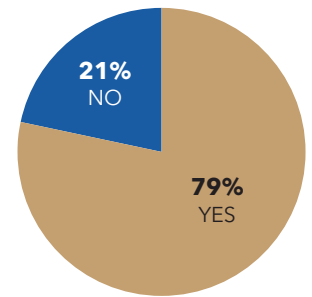
Survey dates: May 29 - June 5\*, 2020 | No. of survey responses: 30

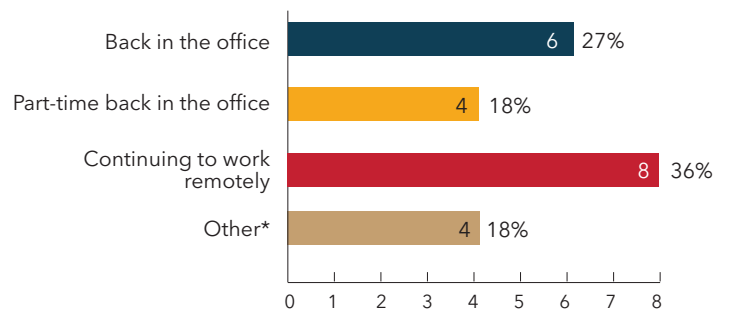
**Question #1:** What measures are you implementing in your organization? Choose all that apply.



**Question #2:** When Safer at Home was in place, did your organization have some employees working remotely?



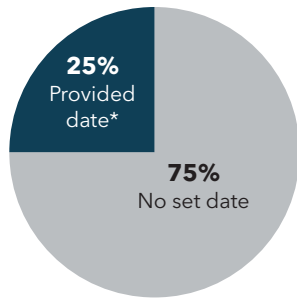
**Question #3:** What is the current status of those remote employees?

- > Staff that can work remotely come in based on the business needs. We estimate a full return in June, yet continuing to monitor the situation and make adjustments accordingly.

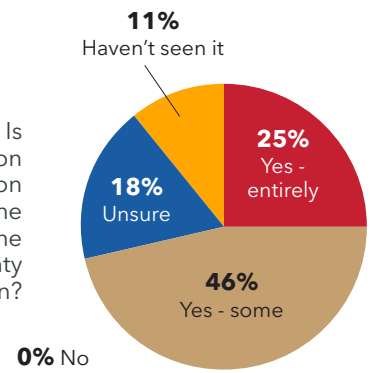
**Question #4:** If you still have employees working remotely, what is the estimated date of return to the office?



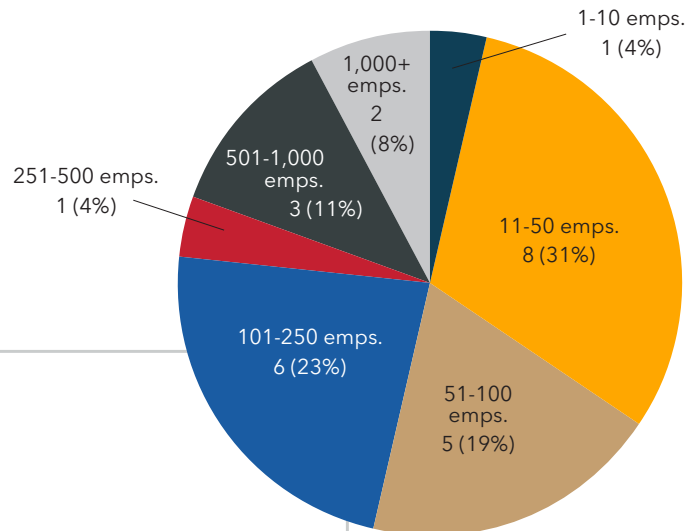
\*Entered return date:
