ECONOMIC IMPACT

- Indirect job creation, with a strong focus on workforce development
- Microsoft is partnering with Gateway Technical College and UW-Milwaukee to train over 100,000 residents in AI and data center skills
- Microsoft campus assessed at \$1.2 billion (up from \$10 million in 2017), with assessed value expected to rise in 2026 with continued on-site construction
- Racine County saw \$1.3 billion in new net construction recorded in 2025, increasing property values by nearly 5%

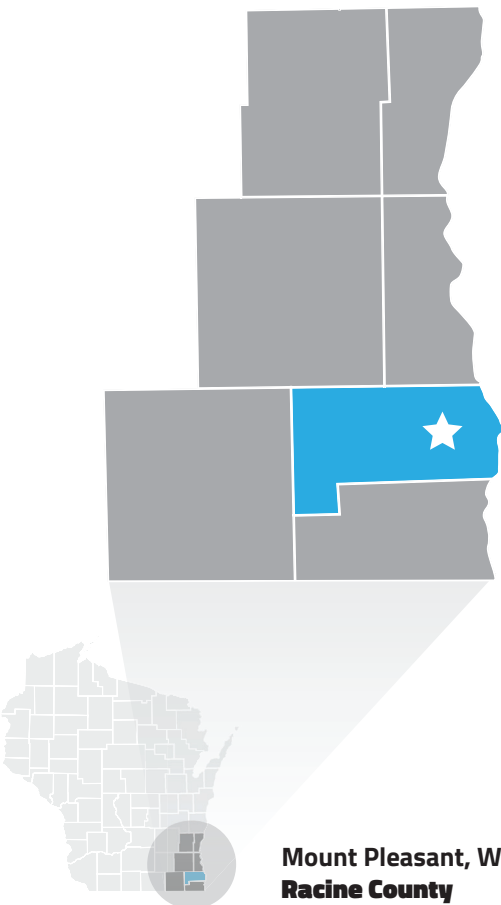

CARE FOR THE COMMUNITY



Microsoft is **FUNDING A \$4.2 MILLION RESTORATION OF LAMPAREK CREEK** in partnership with the Root-Pike Watershed Initiative Network to improve water quality, habitat and flood resilience.

Microsoft is **CONTRIBUTING \$200,000 FOR STEM EDUCATION**, enabling the Racine Unified School District to expand its Girls in STEM program, creating more pathways for young women in science and technology.

Mount Pleasant's data center investment is driving economic growth through job creation, educational partnerships and rising property values, with long-term benefits for residents and public services.
